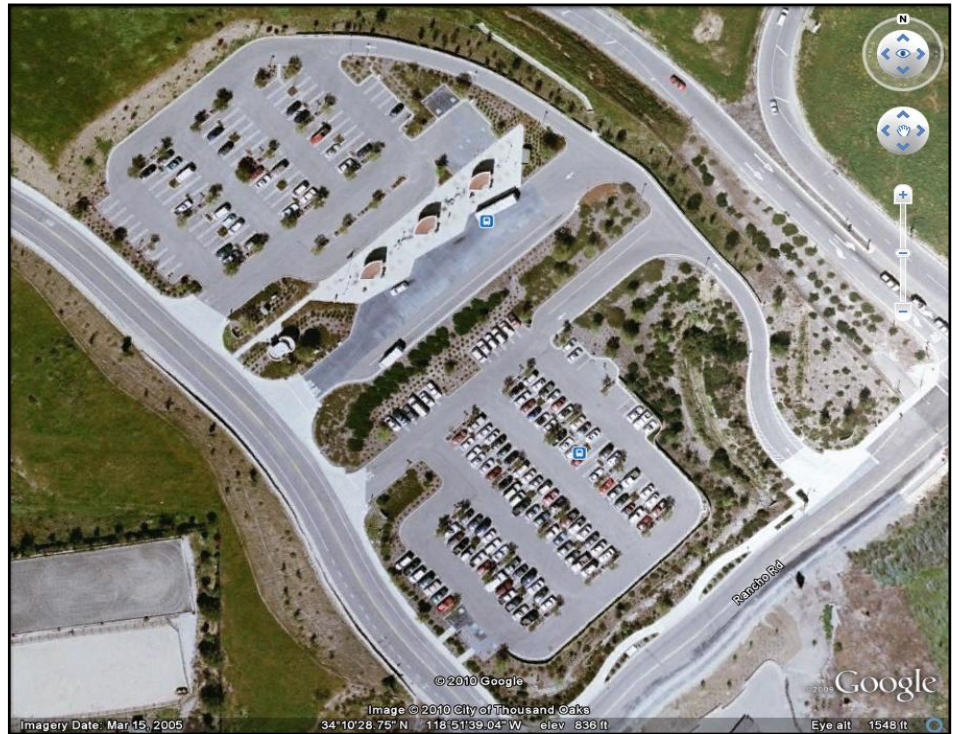

Simplus provided construction management services for the construction of a \$2M community multi-modal transportation facility for the City of Thousand Oaks, California.

Construction management services included managing and coordinating the efforts of the general contractor, numerous subcontractors, City staff, permitting agencies and utility companies (near the site).

Activities included mass earthwork excavation and grading, installation of drainage facilities, construction of curb, gutter and sidewalk, AC paving, striping, signage, lighting, construction of two CMU restrooms, bus shelters, a pedestrian plaza area containing colored concrete, PCC pavement for buses as well as landscaping and irrigation.
