Simplus provided construction management services for the relocation of five national rental car companies to modular facilities at the Long Beach Airport.

Construction management services required extensive planning and coordination with Avis, Hertz, National, Enterprise and Budget Rental Car companies. The work also included managing and coordinating the efforts of William Scotsman, Verizon, Southern California Edison, Sully Miller and RQ Construction as well as multiple subcontractors working with each of the rental car companies to install the modules, install telephone and power services, telecommunications devices in each office, slurry seal and restripe the parking lot, construct new curb gutter and sidewalk, new fencing, gate arms and security control devices.



This project was planned and constructed on a fast track and was constructed within one month. The short schedule required extensive communications with the City of Long Beach Building and Planning Department as well as the Fire Department to make sure all construction was up to code. Simplus worked closely with airport operations staff to complete the work and minimize impacts to existing rental car and airline operations.
