Project coordination for preparation of final design plans, technical specifications, packaging, bid and award of construction contract, oversight of construction manager team and the general contractor, City staff, UPRR and Metrolink staff, permitting agencies, utility companies, and local business owners.

The project involved complete demolition and reconstruction of a UPRR bridge in downtown Los Angeles. The work included drilling of six-foot diameter, 80-foot deep CIDH piles, reconstruction of Soto Street and installation of grade crossing, retaining walls, reinforced concrete abutments, steel girder erection and extensive track construction.
